The purpose of this campaign is to remind ladies to schedule their mammogram and/or bring awareness about the importance of mammograms with the added bonus to make someone smile at our creative bras.

Pink Pumpkins Are also a way to spread breast cancer awareness during Halloween Placing a pink pumpkin on your porch or doorstep may also give someone the push they need to schedule a mammogram. (Note: The CDC recommends annual mammograms for women ages 40-54 and biennial mammograms for women over the age of 55 with a history of normal results.) Regular screenings are vital for early detection of breast cancer — and are more important than ever, especially since the American Cancer Society reported 48,000 fewer mammograms in 2020 due to COVID-19.

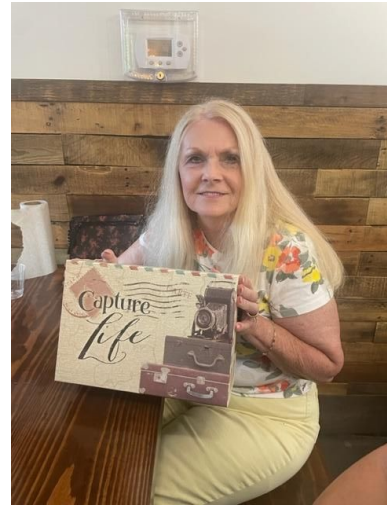
