## March 23th - Easter After Dark Event

We are thrilled to announce that thanks to Ashley DeSalvo Putnam, we have secured an exciting fundraising opportunity to support our charitable initiatives and service projects. We have been granted the chance to host a table at an upcoming event where we will be selling Bobo Balloons. This fundraiser has the potential to greatly benefit our cause, but we will need assistance in transporting the balloons to the event.

#### **Event Details:**

As a reminder, the event is March 23rd from 6-9PM at the New Green Space and Veterans Memorial Lawn in front of the Smyrna Community Center and Smyrna Library. Vendors are expected to stay the entire length of the event, failure to do so will lead to rejection from future events. Since the space is new, we do not have an updated map, when you arrive, staff will show you to your assigned space.

### **Vendor Details:**

Vendors who require power will be placed near power boxes, those who do not require power, will more than likely be stationed in the grass. We will have lighting around the event, but please feel free to bring your own lights (battery powered always make things easier). Vendors are required to bring their own tables, tent, tent weights, and anything else required for your booth to be a success. If you forget something, please let a staff member know, more than likely we have extra supplies in the Community Center.

The egg hunts will take place on the lawn closest to the Community Center. The movie will be facing Veterans Memorial Lawn. Vendors will be set-up around Veterans Memorial Lawn and inbetween the 2 lawns along the pathways.

## Parking:

There are a few different available parking locations for vendors and staff. The easiest place for vendors to park will be at the Smyrna Library (100 Village Green Circle, Smyrna, GA 30080). There is a paved path for vendors to move equipment across and head straight to the

greenspace. Additionally, we do have parking near the Community Center, however, it is not as direct as the library parking lot.

## April 12-13th Tallulah Falls Tour and visit to the State Office




