



501c3 organization that works to respond to the growing number of single mothers and their children who are experiencing homelessness in North Fulton. We involve members of our community in the effort to keep families united under one roof as they work toward self-sufficiency. They are the only agency in the region offering a private crisis-housing program. Every year, our private housing serves two apartment buildings 50 families and 100 children.

In addition to supporting an incredible cause, this event is an opportunity to grow our community. We're asking all current members to invite friends, family, coworkers, church members—anyone who may be interested in connecting with like-minded people and giving back.

Our goals for the event include:

- Collecting gently used women's clothing for The Drake Closet
- Adding at least 10 new prospects to our distribution list
- Welcoming 2 new paid members
- Opening the floor to discuss future service project ideas and potential funding opportunities



Reporting your Hours

Our club has a responsibility to report our hours, in-kind donations, donations, and service projects to our State annually. To ensure that we accurately report this information, it is important for each member to provide us with your data as soon as possible after the completion of each project. By doing so, we can avoid the risk of forgetting how much money we spent, how much time we volunteered, or even the projects we performed. We would like to ask all members to please take the time to report your data to us throughout the year, thereby making it easily accessible to us and ensuring that we fulfill our reporting obligations.

What to report?

As a member, we encourage you to participate in any "club sponsored or promoted events." If you choose to donate, volunteer, or attend a charitable event, or support a charity, we kindly request that you report your hours, donations, and any in-kind contributions made. This includes any DWC projects in which you lend your time or spend money. The reporting form will ask you to specify which project program area it belongs to, such as Arts & Culture, Civic Engagement Outreach, Education, Environment, or Health and Wellness (see below). If you are unsure which category your donation fits in, please do not hesitate to ask Sandi for clarification. Accurate reporting helps us better track the impact of our club's efforts on our community, and ensures that we are making a positive difference in the world.

Examples: If we ask you to donate canned goods or items, that would be considered in-kind. If we take up collections at a meeting and then write a check to a charity, that would be a donation. If you write a check to a club sponsored event directly to the charity that is in-kind donation. All hours, shopping for the charity, attending an event, traveling to/from, participating in a service event - all are reportable volunteer hours.


Membership Information: If you are currently not a member of our club and would like to join us, please <u>click here to complete the membership application</u>.
